His academic interests include comparative civilizations, oral tradition, and symbolic ritual analysis. Dr. Graves is known for his structured lectures, emphasis on archival methodology, and commitment to developing critical thinking in historical study.

Though he rarely discusses his earlier academic work, Dr. Graves' scholarship has been cited in several national conferences and journals. He is currently developing a new interdisciplinary course exploring ancient cultures through anthropological frameworks.
